2011 /Exhibitor/Guidelines

Purpose: The National Association for Practical Nurse Education and Service is the oldest practical nurse organization in the United States. NAPNES promotes quality health care and supports LP/VNs as an integral part of nursing. They provide individual care in a variety of health care settings such as acute care, long-term care, and other community health care agencies. Membership in NAPNES is open to LP/VNs, RNs, physicians, hospital and nursing home administrators, educators, students and anyone who is in harmony with the goals and objectives of NAPNES.

Eligible Exhibits: NAPNES reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in the exposition. Products or services may NOT be sold for delivery in the exposition area.

Exhibit Set-up: 12:00 PM – 4:00 PM Tuesday, August 23, 2011

Dismantle: 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM Thursday, August 25, 2011

Installation and Dismantling: Exhibits must be installed and dismantled during the time indicated above. In no way may exhibitor set up and/or dismantle an exhibit during session breaks. All exhibits will close each day prior to evening social events.

Furnishings: Furniture and/or additional draping, accessories, and signs are the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. Table coverings (provided by hotel) as well as all equipment must be of non-flammable material. All decorative materials must be fire-resistant in accordance with standards established by local regulations and ordinances.

Exhibitors agree not to sublet any space allotted to them without written consent of NAPNES nor to display or advertise goods other than those manufactured or carried by them in the regular course of business. No person, firm, or organization not having contracted with NAPNES for the occupancy of space in the exhibit area will be permitted to display or demonstrate its products, processes or services, distribute advertising materials in the corridors, or in any other way occupy or use the facilities anywhere in the hotel for a purpose inconsistent with these regulations in conjunction with the NAPNES conference.

Exhibitor agrees not to schedule or conduct any outside activities including, but not limited to: receptions, seminars, symposiums, and hospitality suites that are in conflict with the official published program of NAPNES.

If the exhibitor fails to comply in any respect with the terms of this agreement, NAPNES shall have the right, without notice to exhibitor, to offer said space to another exhibitor, or to use said space in any other manner; but this shall not be construed as affecting the sponsor or exhibitors responsibility to pay the full amount specified by the contract.

Exhibitors shall not dispense nor distribute any bulk food items, such as popcorn or peanuts at any time, or any other throw-away items without prior approval of NAPNES. No drink distribution by exhibitors will be allowed.
